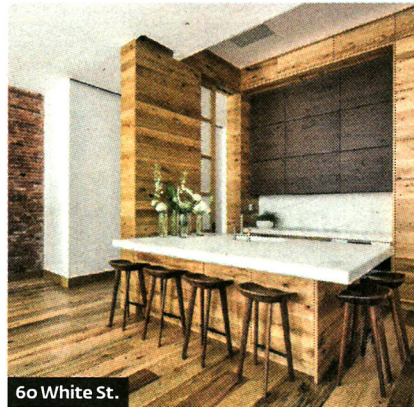
## THE LONG HALL!
